



LAKE VILLAGE TENNIS COURT FACILITY

The Tennis and Pickle Ball Courts are located next to the Pool Facility and are for the use by members of Lake Village Community Association, residents, and their guests. There are two Tennis Courts with both having additional Pickle Ball Court lines. Pickle ball is a game similar to tennis but played on a smaller court, about the size of a badminton court. Instead of a tennis ball and racket, a wiffle ball and a hard paddle like a large ping-pong paddle is used. It's an easy game to learn. For the Health and Safety reasons, dogs are not permitted within the Tennis Court area. Member rest rooms are located in the Pool Area.

HOURS

The tennis court facility hours are: 6:00 AM to 10:00 PM.

TENNIS COURT RULES

- Tennis court rules have been established for the benefit and consideration of Owners, Tenants, Occupants and Guests. These rules are to be adhered to by all.
- A valid Association Key Card or Fob is required in order to enter the tennis court facility.
- Owners, Tenants and Occupants must accompany and stay with their guests.
- Non-marking tennis type shoes must be worn within the tennis court facility at all times.
- Loitering is prohibited within the tennis court facility. Only tennis players and/or maintenance personnel are allowed in the tennis court facility.
- The use of any tobacco products, whether smoked or used otherwise, is not allowed on, or within fifty (50) feet of the tennis court facility. The use of electronic cigarette (or e-cigarette) smoking devices is also prohibited. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted within the tennis court facility. No glass containers are allowed within the tennis court facility.
- Bicycles, skateboards, scooters, razor scooters, roller blades, or roller skates are not permitted within the tennis court facility.
- No pets are permitted within the tennis court facility. An exception will be made for any individual(s) who require(s) the assistance of a "service or assistance animal".

POLICY FOR USE OF THE TENNIS COURTS

Owners, Tenants, Occupants and Guests are encouraged to limit play time to sixty (60) minutes if others are waiting.
